## Regulations for the Establishment of the Career Development Committee

Last Amended on May 21, 2025

- Article 1. The Career Development Committee (the “Committee”) is established at National Taiwan Normal University (“NTNU”) for the purpose of promoting student career development and enhancing the effectiveness of industrial internship initiatives.
- Article 2. The responsibilities of the Committee shall include the following:
1. Integrate NTNU’s resources to develop strategic directions for career development and industrial internship advising.
  2. Guide NTNU in advancing student industrial internship initiatives.
  3. Review and deliberate on matters related to employment and internship advising.
- Article 3. The Committee shall consist of 15 to 21 members, including the President, Vice President, Vice President for Student Affairs, Vice President for Academic Affairs, Vice President for Research and Development, Vice President for International Affairs, Deans of each college, the Dean of the School of Teacher Education, one student representative appointed by the Students’ Union and external legal academics and experts. The President shall serve as the Chairperson of the Committee, and the Vice President for Student Affairs shall serve as the Executive Secretary. The student representative, representatives from cooperative organizations, and external legal academics and experts in the preceding paragraph shall be appointed by the President. Committee members shall serve a one-year term and may be reappointed for consecutive terms.
- Article 4. The Committee shall be convened by the Chairperson at least once per semester. Extraordinary meetings may be held when deemed necessary.
- Article 5. Committee meetings require the presence of a majority of members to constitute a quorum. Resolutions shall be adopted with the approval of more than half of the attending members. Representatives from the proposing unit or relevant faculty members may be invited to attend Committee meetings to provide explanations or consultations.
- Article 6. These Regulations and any amendments thereto shall become effective upon approval by the University Council.
